**Do not** go to the home of maintenance or management and **NEVER** approach or interrupt maintenance/anyone when they are working.

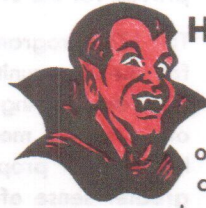
